Summary of Position:

Reporting to the Environmental Manager, the Environmental Coordinator will coordinate and facilitate various environmental compliance projects, coordinate permit applications, and assist in the production of environmental reports.

Essential Functions:

- Provide guidance, support, and direction to the project team to ensure the effective coordination and timing of the required permits and approvals as they relate to the project schedule.
- Assist in the permit conditions compliance tracking for the project
- Ensure regulatory compliance as that is a key objective of the project's Environmental Management System.
- Monitor field inspections, surveys, sampling and walk downs of environment related activities to assure field activities, conditions and outcomes correspond with the requirements of permits.
- Liaising with third party agencies and other relevant authorities, such as municipal/ provincial/ regional/ federal governments and other stakeholders, as necessary, to identify PLA requirements and follow up on PLA applications.
- Provide Environmental Awareness and Orientation Training through on-site orientation, toolbox talks and procedure rollouts, and advise project team members in support of environmental permit quality standards, objectives, guidelines, policies, procedures and legislation.
- Completing weekly noise and vibration monitoring reports through coordination

Qualifications:

- Degree in Environmental Engineering, Environmental Science or a related technical field
- 1-3 years' experience with project management in the construction industry; transit industry preferred.
- Thorough understanding of various legislation and regulation such as Transit Project Assessment Process, Ontario and Canadian Environmental Assessment processes, Environmental Protection Act, Endangered Species Act, Migratory Bird Convention Act, Planning Act and Class Environmental Assessments
- Knowledge of environmental approvals would be an asset.
- Strong organizational skills, and high attention to detail is necessary.
